Sub : Proposal for Conversion of the existing Town Committee  
into Municipal Board AND Extension of Boundary of the  
existing Municipal Board and Town Committee.

Sir,

It appears from the old records in this office that certain Town Committees had earlier submitted proposal for extension of its boundary and also for conversion of the Town Committee into Municipal Board in certain cases. The proposals were not submitted in proper order and also not routed through the authorities as required, and as such it is difficult to process the said proposals now and require fresh proposals for consideration by the Government.

I would therefore request you kindly to submit proposals if any relating to your Municipal Board/Town Committee regarding Extension of the existing boundary or conversion of the Town Committee into Municipal Board as per provisions of the Assam Municipal Act, 1956. It is informed for your guidance that as per provision of the A.M. Act, 1956 the Municipal Board should have at least 8 wards and as such if the existing Town Committee is having less than 8 wards should submit proposal for delimitation of the extension of the existing Town Committee submission of the proposal for conversion of the Town Committee into Municipal Board.

Further you are to take into account the following points and submit particulars against each points while submitting the proposal for extension of the existing Municipal Board/Town Committee and also Conversion of the existing Town Committee into Municipal Board.

1. Present population as per 1991 census.
2. No. of wards.
3. No. of Committees.

4. Whether once extension proposal has been submitted.
5. If so, indicate the population of the proposed area of extension separately.
6. Percentage of Non-agriculturist population of the area of extension.
7. A detailed map of the proposed area of extension.
8. Probable income from the proposed extended area.

You are to submit the proposal through your concerned S.D.O. (c) / Deputy Commissioner who will recommend the proposal to the respective Commissioners of Divisions from whom the proposal will be sent to the Government with intimation to the undersigned.
